
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Guy Lacey

Penodwyd Guy yn Brif Weithredwr/ Pennaeth Coleg Gwent ym mis Awst 2015. Fe raddiodd Guy o Brifysgol Oxford Brookes ac mae ganddo gymwysterau ôl-raddedig mewn Addysg Uwchradd o Brifysgol Caerfaddon. Mae Guy wedi treulio 25 mlynedd mewn ystod o ysgolion a cholegau yn y DU. Mae wedi gweithio fel arholwr TGAU ar gyfer Cambridge Assessment ac wedi gweithio fel Arolygydd cymheiriaid gydag Estyn ers dros ddeng mlynedd. Ef yw Cadeirydd ColegauCymru a chafodd ei benodi'n Ddirprwy Raglaw Gwent yn 2021.

Guy was appointed CEO/Principal of Coleg Gwent in August 2015. He graduated from Oxford Brookes University and has post graduate qualifications in Secondary Education from Bath University. He has spent 25 years in several UK schools and colleges. Guy has worked as a GCSE examiner for Cambridge Assessment and worked as a peer Inspector with Estyn for over ten years. Bu hefyd yn gweithio am saith mlynedd fel Ysgrifennydd Cyffredinol Llafur Cymru. Cyn hyn bu'n Swyddog Cyswllt Gwleidyddol i Undeb Prifysgolion a Choleg Cymru, ac fel Pennaeth Polisi Llafur Cymru. Mae gan David dros 20 mlynedd o brofiad yn gweithio ym mywyd cyhoeddus Cymru, gyda chefnidir cryf mewn gwleidyddiaeth a phrofiad o ddatblygu polisi.

Mae Richard yn Gymrawd Gymdeithas Ddysgedig Cymru ac Academi'r Gwyddorau Cymdeithasol.

Richard is the Director of Cardiff University's Welsh Governance Centre, and recently stepped down as the University's Dean of Public Affairs after a decade in the role. Ym mis Mai 2021 fe'i penodwyd yn Weinidog dros Addysg a'r Gymraeg. Ar ôl graddio, bu Jeremy yn dysgu'r gyfraith ym Mhrifysgol Warsaw yng Ngwlad Pwyl. Yn ddiweddarach, bu'n gweithio fel cyfreithiwr yn Llundain ac yna daliodd uwch swyddi cyfreithiol a masnachol mewn busnesau yn y sector cyfryngau. Mae Jeremy wedi bod yn ymddiriedolwr ac ysgrifennydd Sefydliad Bevan.

Jeremy was elected to the National Assembly for Wales for the Neath constituency in May 2016 as the Labour and Co-operative party candidate. In May 2021 he was appointed Minister for Education and Welsh Language. After graduating, Jeremy taught law at Warsaw University in Poland. Later, he practised as a solicitor in London and then held senior legal and commercial posts in media sector businesses. Jeremy has been a trustee and secretary of the Bevan Foundation.

Jeff's career in education began as a teacher in the South Wales Valleys, then as a civil servant developing the National Curriculum for Modern Languages. In 1999, Jeff joined Ufi to help set up the first UK national network of learning online centres, Learndirect. In 2015, he set up coaching and entrepreneurship programmes for Individuals and businesses, and currently sits on the Board of several UK Education and Training think Tanks.

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
