Mae ei chyfrifoldebau'n cynnwys strategaeth Addysg Drydyddol ac Ymchwil, polisi a chyllid, Medr, Ansawdd addysg drydyddol a phrofiad y dysgwr, Addysg Gydol Oes, Taith, a'r Gweithlu Addysg Ôl-16 gan gynnwys cyflog ac amodau, llwyth gwaith a lles.

Rhwng 2000 a 2016, bu Vikki yn gweithio fel athrawes Hanes yng Nghaerffili. Mae ei diddordebau gwleidyddol yn cynnwys addysg; trafnidiaeth a'r economi; mynd i'r afael â thlodi; chwarae cynhwysol; adfywio cymunedol; a threftadaeth a diwylliant.

Vikki Howells MS was appointed the Welsh Government Minister for Further and Higher Education in September 2024. Her responsibilities include, Tertiary Education and Research strategy, policy and funding, Medr, Quality of tertiary education and learner experience, Lifelong Learning, Taith, and Post-16 Education Workforce including pay and conditions, workload and wellbeing.

Between 2000 and 2016, Vikki worked as a History teacher in Caerphilly. Her political interests include education; transport and the economy; tackling poverty; inclusive play; community regeneration; and heritage and culture.

Thomas has lived and worked in Wales for around twenty years. He attended Swansea University, where he read Economics. Thomas then completed his Masters in Economics at the University of Exeter. He joined the Civil Service as an economist working for the Department for Education, before doing a PhD in economics at Cardiff University.

He joined the Welsh Government in 2009, having worked in the Economy and Welsh Treasury teams. Thomas has been Chief Economist at the Welsh Government since early 2024.
